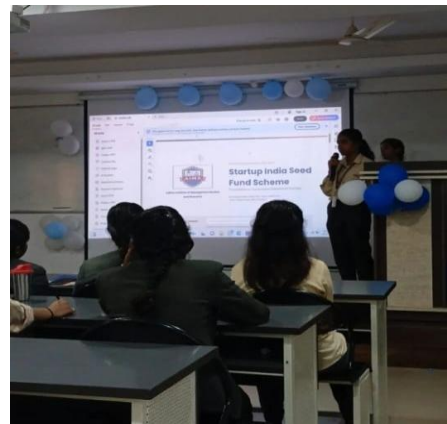
Intra-Institutional Hackathon 25-Nov-2025
